Uncomfortable with myself (after 3 / 4 sessions)

Not outgoing / socially awkward

Wouldn't stand up to slurs / discrimination

Need to be challenged to think about the difference OY makes

- suggestion bi-monthly review
- checking in to give people individual time to check are OK
- to help young people become activists with OY



Comfortable enough to wear clothing that suits

More outgoing

OPEN EVENT

Who is coming?

- people who can support us

When people arrive – welcome them / badges / VIP passes

Make it fluid not formal

Informal event – posters / pomp oms (Hayden)

Give people a plan for the evening

We think this is too many people - - smaller group – young people might not cope

Have structure so we know what's going on

Update our display boards – young people Asger / Hayden

Speed dating “conversations” – your experience / the difference – what OY is currently doing – what would the person you are talking to bring to OY – how can they help
